1.0 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this policy is to establish an official forum for the approval and recommendation of policies governing academic and student development issues.

2.0 POLICY

It is the policy of the College that Academic Council be established as the academic body of the College responsible for advising the President on academic policy, programs and student development issues. Academic Council (AC) will provide for collegial and participatory decision making in a forum consisting of representatives from all academic and academic support constituencies including faculty, academic support staff, students and academic administrators. All recommendations presented by Academic Council will be presented to the President for approval as the final authority in accordance with Board Policy GP-RR-904.

3.0 PROCEDURE

The Senior Vice President Academic and Chief Learning Officer shall ensure that procedures are developed and implemented in accordance with this policy.
