1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this policy is to describe the College position as it relates to requiring students to meet specific medical conditions prior to entrance into a program of studies.

2. POLICY

It is the policy of the College that students will not be denied access to a program based on the grounds of a medical requirement except in training programs where outside agencies impose health standards for the training environment. The College also reserves the right to counsel and/or require a student to undergo a medical examination if the health, welfare and/or safety of that student, other students, or college staff may be in jeopardy.

3. PROCEDURE

Medical forms must be completed by a health care professional and submitted to the Registrar's Office prior to or at registration.

4. RESPONSIBILITY

The Senior Vice President Academic and Chief Learning Officer shall be responsible for monitoring and reviewing this policy.
