1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This policy applies to all registered students at the College. It is intended to establish the students' rights and responsibilities and to act as a guide for the students as well as all College personnel.

2. POLICY

While many parties work together to ensure a student's success in education, upon registration, the College enters into a contract with every individual student. This contract includes an expectation that every student conduct themselves in the best interest of the College and themselves. All students are expected to apply themselves to their studies and act with propriety and conform to College policies, rules and regulations. If students do not accept and live up to these responsibilities as outlined, the College reserves the right to take such action as, in its opinion, the case warrants (*See College Policy SS-202.*)

3. PROCEDURE

The Senior Vice-President Academic and Chief Learning Officer shall ensure that procedures are developed and implemented in accordance with this policy.
