NOTE: *Included in other fees column for the Fall Semester is the Health and Dental – Single portion- \$390.00; \$97 Confirmation Fee; \$210 Equipment and Materials Fee ; \$125 First Aid; \$50 Academic Administrative Fee*

Supplies:

Steel nose safety boots (CSA Z195-02); safety eyewear (glasses or goggles - CSA Z94.3, Class I); 2 pairs coveralls (CSA 96-09, Class II, Level II, 100% cotton); welding gloves; hearing protection (ear muffs/ear plugs); personal half-face, negative-pressure, air-purifying respirator to be utilized during period of long use of oils and lubricants. These respirators should be equipped with a combination of organic vapor cartridge/P100 filter (3M/60921 or equivalent). When purchasing a respirator, a "Mask Fit Test" is required to ensure that the correct size is purchased. We recommend that the purchase be made from a supplier that can also perform a certifiable "Mask Fit Test".

All students must supply their own tool kit: Tool box, brake spring pliers; brake shoe retaining spring tool; brake adjusting tool, blow gun; chisels; steel punches (including centre punch); wire crimping tool; flashlight; feeler gauge (standard/metric); hack saw (12" saw and blades); hammer (2.5 - 3 lbs ball peen); hammer (2.5 - 3 lbs plastic); hex key set (standard); hex key set (metric); inspection mirror; johnson bar; 12" channel lock pliers; mechanic pick set; multimeter (DVOM); pliers set (8" needle nose, 10" vice grips, combination diagonal cutters, snap ring-internal and external); pry bar set; ratchet and sockets (1/4, 3/8, 2 drive - standard/metric); 12" steel ruler (metric/standard graduated in 32nds and mm); scraper (gasket and carbon); screwdrivers (3 phillips, 3 flat, torx); 12' tape; test lamp (12 volt); tire pressure gauge; torx bits set; tread depth gauge (for tires and brakes); utility knife; vernier caliper (sae with sliding precision of .001"); vernier caliper (metric with sliding precision of .001"); wire brush; wire strippers; wrench set (12 point, 3/8" to 1 1/4" AND 3mm to 24 mm); Welding goggles #5; MIG Welding Shield #8 Shade; rechargeable LED shoplight; scribe. NOTE: To prevent purchasing tools of inferior quality and repurchasing: Hacksaw: Strong frame. Vice Grips: The brand "Vise Grips" are recommended. Vernier Caliper: Not plastic.
