→Hard hat (CSA Z94.1-05, Type 2, Class E); steel toe safety boots (CSA Z195-02); safety glasses (CSA Z94.3, Class 1)

→allen keys (1 metric set AND 1 standard set); applicators (2 sets of 3); chisels (1 set of 5); drill bits (1 set); files; hack saw; 3 hammers (bumping, pick, ball peen); measuring tape; needle nose pliers; linesman pliers; punches; putty knife; ratchets (1 set); razor blades and holder; 3 sanding blocks (5", 8.5", and soft block); screwdrivers (set); sockets (combination set); trim clip removal tools (1 narrow and 1 wide); utility knife; wrenches (combination set); air blow gun; air purifying respirator; tool box, paint suit; welding clamps; welding gloves, calculator and tool box with wheels, castors (must be portable).
