1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of the Medical Requirements Policy (the Policy) is to describe College of the North Atlantic (CNA) position as it relates to requiring students to meet specific medical conditions prior to entrance into a program of studies.

2. POLICY

It is the policy of CNA that students will not be denied access to a program based on the grounds of a medical requirement except in training programs where outside agencies impose health standards for the training environment. CNA also reserves the right to counsel and/or require a student to undergo a medical examination if the health, welfare, and/or safety of that student, other students, or CNA staff may be in jeopardy.

3. PROCEDURE

The Vice President, Academics and Applied Research shall ensure that procedures are developed and implemented in accordance with the Policy.
