- Steel nose safety boots (CSA Z195-02), safety eyewear (glasses or goggles - CSA Z94.3, Class I); 2 pairs coveralls (CSA 96-09, Class II, Level II, 100% cotton); welding gloves; hearing protection (ear muffs/ear plugs); personal half-face, negative pressure, air-purifying respirator to be utilized during period of long use of oils and lubricants. These respirators should be equipped with a combination of organic vapor cartridge/P100 filters (3M/60921 or equivalent). When purchasing a respirator, a Mask Fit Test" is required to ensure that the correct size is purchased. We recommend that the purchase be made from a supplier that can also perform a certifiable "Mask Fit Test"
