



## **Welder/Fabricator Program Safety Equipment & Tools Required for 2nd year Returning Students**

<b>List of Supplies</b>	<b>Approximate Cost</b>
Welding Hard Hat	\$ 40
Welding Helmet (must attach to the Hard Hat) 2 x 4 Flip Up Standard Helmet <i>(Students are not required to have this particular hard hat and helmet; however, they must ensure that their helmet is designed to fit their hard hat)</i>	\$ 60
Steel Toe Boots (CSA approved)(Not Rubber Boots)	\$ 100 – 150
Coveralls or Bibbed-overalls	\$ 50+
Clear Safety Glasses	\$ 10
#4 or #5 shade cutting glasses or goggles (lift front) <i>(If you wear glasses, then goggles would be better suited)</i>	\$ 15
Welding Gloves/Tig Gloves	\$ 12
5" Wirer Wheel <i>(CNA will provide grinding discs for 5" grinders only)</i>	\$ 120
Welding Jacket	\$ 100
Measuring Tape <i>(tape must have both standard and metric measurements; inexpensive tapes are quite sufficient)</i>	\$ 5
Chipping Hammer/Wire Brush	\$20
Half Mask with Hepa Filter (Available at the Campus)	\$35

Most of the above equipment can be purchased anywhere welding supplies are sold.

**NOTE: Make sure the Welding helmet fits the Hard Hat and also that the Welding Jacket is the right size (100% P.P.E.).**
