Students accepted into programs in the School of Health Sciences must complete their Program Awareness form and proof of current immunization status prior to registration. Your immunization record can be obtained from the Department of Health. Prospective students should NOTE CAREFULLY that while the College may admit students to a course of studies in the School of Health Sciences, the right to practice is granted only through the appropriate authority of the Province in conjunction with national registration/certification bodies. Applicants with prior convictions or offences, or mental/physical disabilities should communicate with the appropriate organization involved.

If your program of studies has a clinical or field placement and you obtain a clinical or field placement with the Health Boards, you will be required to provide a Certificate of Conduct prior to this period. The Certificate of Conduct can be obtained from your local police department or the RCMP. There is a processing fee payable to them for this certificate.

In order to protect your confidentiality, we encourage you to return your medical documentation in a separate envelope with your name and Medical Records wrote on it. You may choose to fax this information, however we cannot guarantee confidentiality if you decide to do so.
