Credit Union Bursary Program

Donor: Credit Unions in Atlantic Canada

Number of Awards: Four (one each for four geographic regions)

Value: \$1000 each

Criteria:

- Awarded to a full-time student enrolled in the second year or greater of any diploma or degree program.
- Students must demonstrate academic merit, financial need, a commitment to completing their studies, and community/college involvement.
- One award for each geographic region
- Special consideration may be given to students who:
 - a) Can demonstrate an affiliation with the credit union system and / or
 - b) Are members from traditionally underrepresented communities.

Geographic locations are defined as:

Central: Bonavista, Burin, Clarenville, Gander, Grand Falls – Windsor

Eastern: Carbonear, Placentia, Seal Cove, St. John's (Prince Philip Drive, Ridge Road)

Western: Bay St. George, Corner Brook, Port aux Basques, St. Anthony

Labrador: Happy Valley-Goose Bay, Labrador West

- A brief essay (form attached) describing the applicant's educational goals, career aspirations and community involvement activities.
