In 2011, the Hebron Project co-venturers established an endowment of \$750,000 at the College for women, Indigenous people, persons living with a disability and racialized groups. The Hebron Project Diversity Scholarship Fund will assist students from among these groups, with a preference for those who are enrolled in Engineering Technology and Industrial Trades programs.

Value: \$1500 each

Criteria:

- Available to full time students at any campus who identify as indigenous, living with a disability or represent a racialized group.
- Recipients must be enrolled in an Industrial Trades or Engineering Technology programs.
- Based on academic merit and reference.

Required Documents:

- Common Scholarship Application
- College Reference Form
- Student Progress Report for Industrial Trade Students (for courses that are still in progress and not on college transcript)

Deadline: Mid-January
