- Is enrolled in 2nd or 3rd year of an Applied Science/Engineering Technology program that is accredited by Technology Accreditation Canada (TAC), or accepted by AETTNL as leading to membership in the association; and,
- Is a student member in good standing of AETTNL.

After meeting these criteria, selection will be based (in order of precedence shown) on:

- High academic achievement: specifically the highest cumulative GPA;
- Involvement in extracurricular activities; and,
- Community or volunteer service.
