AETTNL College Scholarship Criteria

To be eligible to apply for these scholarships, students must meet the following criteria:

- be a registered student member in good standing with AETTNL;
- be enrolled as a full-time student in a Technician or Technology program accredited by the Technology Accreditation Canada (TAC) or accepted by AETTNL as leading to membership in the Association;
- be in their second or third year of study in the program; and,
- have a minimum academic weighted grade of 75%.

Award of scholarships will be based on academic merit, and successful candidates will be selected by members of the AETTNL Scholarship Committee.
