What is CAS Transition?

Comprehensive Arts and Science (CAS) Transition is designed for high school and Adult Basic Education graduates who would like to improve their general employability skills or who are lacking either the academic courses or the required grades to meet the entrance requirements of the college program they would like to enter. The Transition program also provides a valuable “refresher” for mature students who have been away from education, training and/or the workforce for some time.

Requirements for Program Completion

To be awarded the CAS Transition certificate, students must attain 40 credits and maintain a 2.0 GPA. Credits must include:

- 10 Required Credits (English I and II)
- 20 Core Credits
- 10 Elective Credits

Core and elective credits may be chosen from the fields of general education, social sciences, exploration and student success courses.

Students can take electives from other College programs provided prerequisites/co-requisites are met and the student's schedule can be accommodated.



CAS Transition vs Adult Basic Education

CAS Transition

Entrance Requirements: High school graduation or equivalent

Curriculum: Post-secondary level courses that provide equivalency to high school entrance requirements for CNA programs and/or Memorial University

Electives from other College programs and/or select MUN transferable courses can be completed

Adult Basic Education

Entrance Requirements: 19 years of age and a resident of Canada

Curriculum: Level I (equivalent to K-6), Level II (equivalent to grades 7-9), Level III (equivalent to grades 10-12); 36 credits required to graduate with a high school diploma issued by the Department of Education
