

## **Physical Distancing and Hygiene Protocols – Gander Campus**

The Faculty, Administration, and Support Staff of Gander Campus welcomes all new and returning students to the fall 2022 semester. We will all do what we can to make your learning environment as safe, productive, and enjoyable as possible, but in order to do so we will need your help. In order to complete practical training in a COVID-19 environment, physical distancing and hygiene protocols are required on campus. For the shop and lab areas, faculty will outline protocols for you during their orientations. Outside of these areas, there are several other requirements we should all follow for health and safety's sake

- Signage pertaining to physical distancing and hygiene protocols will be posted around campus. You must follow posted protocols. All washrooms will also have signage designating maximum occupancy. Please follow posted directions.
- You are to follow any directional arrows provided and to maintain physical distancing with a 6-foot distance.
- You are to bring a non-surgical mask whenever you are required to be on site. These masks are to be worn in all transitional areas (and washrooms) and any time physical distancing should be deemed impossible. Regulations on mask requirements are subject to change at any time depending upon Public Health Restrictions surrounding COVID-19 protocols
- Increased hand sanitizing stations will be provided throughout the facility. Enhanced cleaning measures will be established to sanitize/disinfect surfaces, tools, and equipment.
- If you require study/training material, you are required to provide your own or it will be given to you by your instructor. Plans, educational materials, resources, etc., are not to be shared.
- If you are exhibiting any signs or symptoms of COVID-19, please stay home and contact 811.
- No external visitors are permitted on campus at this time.
- As with the current Public Health Restrictions in place in the province, any on campus requirements and/or restrictions are subject to change at any time. Changes in requirements and restrictions will be communicated to you through your CNA webmail address.
