

- Can be set up on your smartphone


Students are encouraged to use and check their email often because Important information is sent by college staff and instructors about Programming, campus closures, scholarships, etc.

Visit the App store and download "Outlook"

You will be forwarded to a page where it will prompt you to enter your password for your college email.


Enter the password and press "Sign In with Office 365"

Step 4:

A message should pop up asking you to either turn on or off notifications; turn it on so you get a notification when you get an email. Your e-mail is now set-up! The orange circle is the college email and if you click the one in under it you can add another email such as a personal.





Peer Tutoring

- Students needing academic assistance are paired with other students in good academic standing
- Tutors earn \$15/hour
- Students are eligible for up to 15 hours per semester of peer tutoring based on application and recommendation from their instructor or academic advisor
