



Canada Student Loans Program and Newfoundland and Labrador Student Financial Services Emergency Response Measures 2020-2021

The following measures will be in effect for the 2020-2021 program year only:

Full-time Students

- Canada Student Loan has increased the maximum weekly amount from \$210 to \$350
- Canada Student Grant for Full-time Students has doubled from \$375 to \$750a week, to a maximum of \$6000 a school year
- The Province has increased its weekly loan limit by \$60 to \$100 a week
- Canada Student Grant for Students with a Permanent Disability has doubled to \$4000
- Canada Student Grant for Full-time Students with Dependents has increased to \$400 per dependent per month of study (\$3200 per dependent per academic year)

Part-time Students

- Canada Student Grant for Part-time Students has doubled from \$1800 to \$3600 a year
- Canada Student Grant for Part- time Students with Dependents has doubled from \$40 to \$80 for 1 or 2 dependents and \$120 per week for 3 or more to a maximum of \$3840 a year
- Canada Student Grant for Students with a Permanent Disability has doubled to \$4000

The full-time and part-time student initiatives mean that students may be eligible to borrow more money, as well as receive more non-repayable money (grants).

Assessment

• The federal and provincial needs assessment calculation will not include student and spousal contributions.

This will mean students may be assessed with a greater financial need than they would if these contributions were included.
