

## Parental Consent for Youth Hunting and/or Trapping

Section 91.2 of the Wild Life Regulations of the Wild Life Act require a youth aged 12 to 17 to have the written consent of a parent or person who has custody of the youth in order to acquire a licence that permits the use of a firearm to shoot small game, fur bearing animals or big game. *The youth or a designated adult accompanying and supervising the youth must also carry the written consent while carrying, transporting, possessing or using firearms in any place frequented by wild life.*
